



TRAVEL POLICY

Transportation

- Parents/guardians are responsible for arranging transportation for athletes to/from regattas.

Lodging

- BRC will reserve rooms for athletes to share. All athletes must stay in the same hotel for regattas. The cost of the rooms/team meals will be communicated to parents/guardians at least 2 weeks before the regatta.
- Typically, 4 athletes are assigned to each room, separating boys and girls.
- If athletes will be staying in their parent's room, please let the President or Vice President know as soon as the regatta schedule is finalized.
- BRC will have a hotel block with a group rate. Parents/guardians are responsible for booking their own room.

Behavior Expectations

- Athletes must always adhere to the team's Code of Conduct.
- Team socializing is allowed only in designated public areas, such as the hotel lobby.
- Athletes must stay on hotel property. They may leave only with a designated parent/guardian/chaperone.
- Athletes will respect other hotel guests by minimizing noise and avoiding shenanigans in rooms, hallways, and public areas.
- Athletes will not damage or remove hotel property, and parents/guardians will be held liable for any damage/loss.
- Athletes shall observe designated curfew times and will not leave their room after room check except in an emergency to find a chaperone.

Athlete Supervision

- At the venue, the coaches are in charge.
- At the hotel, the chaperones are in charge.
- Athletes are expected to always act safely and responsibly, and exercise good judgment. If a serious violation occurs, an athlete may not be able to race and/or their parent/guardian may be asked to come and get them immediately.
